



TOWN OF ANTHONY

A RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF ANTHONY, TEXAS ON May 3, 2025 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR PLACES 1 AND 2 FOR FOUR-YEAR TERMS.

- **WHEREAS**, the Charter of the Town of Anthony, Texas, provides that general elections for Mayor and Council Members are held on the May uniform election date;
- **WHEREAS**, the terms of office for the Mayor and Council Members in Seats 1 and 2 will expire, and those positions must be filled for four-year terms;
- **WHEREAS**, the general election date established by this Resolution shall be MAY 3, 2025 which is the May uniform election date in 2025; and
- **WHEREAS**, upon election, the terms of office for the Mayor and Council Members in Seats 1 and 2 shall each be for four (4) years, as provided by the Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANTHONY:

SECTION I.

That in compliance and accordance with the laws and constitution of the State of Texas, an election shall be and the same is hereby called and ordered for May 3, 2025 for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor for a term of four (4) years; and two (2) Council Members for Seats 1 and 2 for terms of four (4) years each.

SECTION II.

The Town Clerk, together with the El Paso County Elections Administrator, shall prepare the official ballot for said election. The ballot shall designate the Places for Mayor and Council Members as Mayor, Place 1, and Place 2, respectively.

SECTION III.

That no person's name shall be placed upon the official ballot as a candidate for the position unless such person has filed a sworn application, in compliance with the laws of Texas, no sooner than January 15, 2025 nor after February 15, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. The designation of the Place the candidate is seeking must appear on the face of the application.

SECTION IV.

That the polls shall be kept open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election, and at such election, all qualified voters in the Town are authorized to vote for his or her choice of candidate for each place and shall vote for one candidate only for each place, with the due return being made to the Council showing the number of votes cast for each candidate for each of the positions of Council Members.

SECTION V.

That Lisa Wise, County Elections Administrator, shall be the early voting clerk for said election. The County Courthouse, 500 E. San Antonio, El Paso, Texas, is hereby designated as the main early voting polling place for said election. In addition, early voting may also occur at such branch early voting polling places as are designed herein or otherwise designated by the El Paso County Elections Administrator and for which notice is given, and early voting on Saturday and Sunday is ordered. The Town Clerk is authorized to revise or add exhibits to this Resolution and to the Order of Election designating these early voting locations and times for voting as are established or revised by the El Paso County Elections Administrator.

Applications for ballot by mail shall be submitted to the Early Voting Clerk: 500 E. San Antonio, Lower Level, Ste. Ll 15, El Paso, TX 79901, no later than the close of regular business in the Early Voting Clerk's office, or 12 noon, whichever is later on the <u>11th day</u> before the date of the Election or as may otherwise be required by law.

SECTION VI.

That a candidate who receives a majority of all of the votes cast for the office for which he or she is a candidate shall be elected for such office. In the event of a tie, the provisions of Section 2.002 of the Texas Election Code, or other applicable state statute dealing with a "Tie Vote," shall be followed. If a runoff election is required to elect an officer by a majority vote, it shall be held on a date as permitted by the Texas Election Code. Such election, if any, shall be called by the City Council. Early voting dates and sites will be identified if such runoff election shall be held.

SECTION VII.

Electronic voting machines, as certified for use by the El Paso County Elections Administrator, shall be used for voting at the regular polling places in such election, and for the casting of early ballots by persons voting early by personal appearance.

SECTION VIII.

That this Resolution, signed by the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk, shall constitute the proclamation of the Mayor calling and ordering said election, and that the Town Clerk is directed to prepare the appropriate notice of election containing the directives of this Resolution and the Order of Election, as required by the Texas Election Code. The Town Clerk shall give notice of such election in English and Spanish by posting such notice at the Town Hall and by publishing a copy of such notice in a newspaper as required by law.

SECTION IX.

The Town Clerk shall deliver notice of this election to the County Clerk and Voter Registrar of El Paso County as required by law, not later than February 14, 2025.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANTHONY, TEXAS, ORDERING AND DECLARING THAT THE HOME RULE CHARTER APPROVED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE ANTHONY CITIZENS ON NOVEMBER 5, 2024, IS ADOPTED.

WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution grants the power of local self-government to home-rule cities and states that once a city has more than 5,000 inhabitants, it is authorized to hold an election on the matter of adopting a home-rule city charter; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has previously found that the City's population exceeded 5, 000 inhabitants, and Town Council established a Home-Rule Charter commission to draft a proposed Town of Anthony Charter to be submitted to the qualified voters at an election on the matter; and

WHEREAS, an election was held on November 5, 2024, on the question of whether the Town of Anthony should adopt a Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the official canvass of the returns of the election on November 18, 2024, showed that a majority of citizens of the Town of Anthony voted to adopt the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code section 9.005(b), the Town Council finds and determines that it must issue an order in the City records declaring the charter adopted and making the newly adopted charter effective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANTHONY, TEXAS:

1. FINDINGS OF FACTS

The Town Council of the City of Anthony hereby orders and declares that the Home Rule Charter approved by the citizens of the City of Anthony on November 5, 2024, is hereby adopted.

2. RECITALS

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

3. NOTICE

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public and that the public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 551. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 395 of the Code.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
